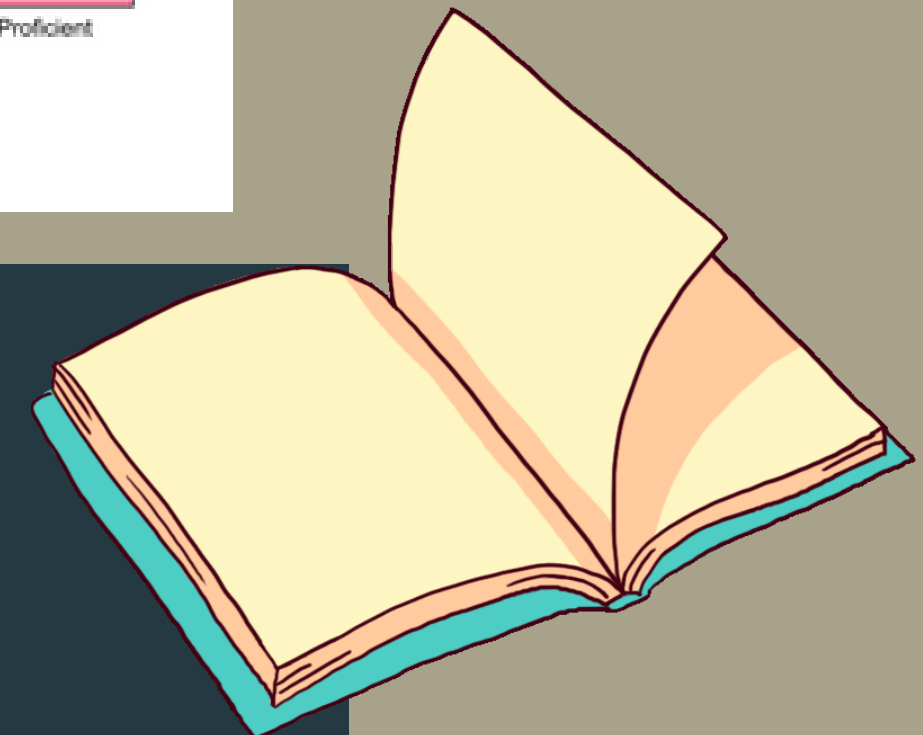
Understanding Complex Texts

This indicator tells if you are understanding the central meaning of complex texts at a level that is needed to succeed in college courses with higher reading demand.



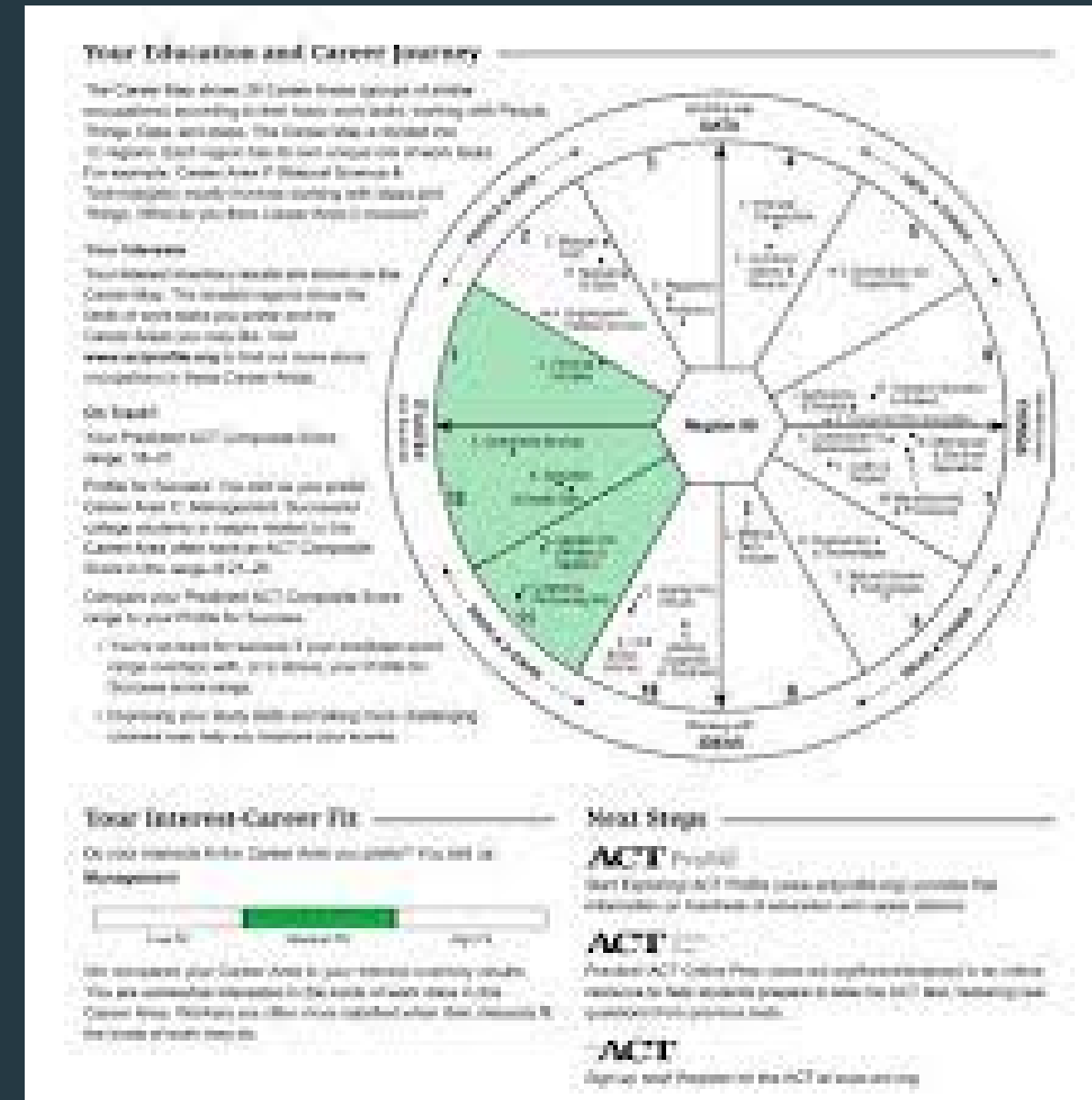
REPORTING CATEGORIES

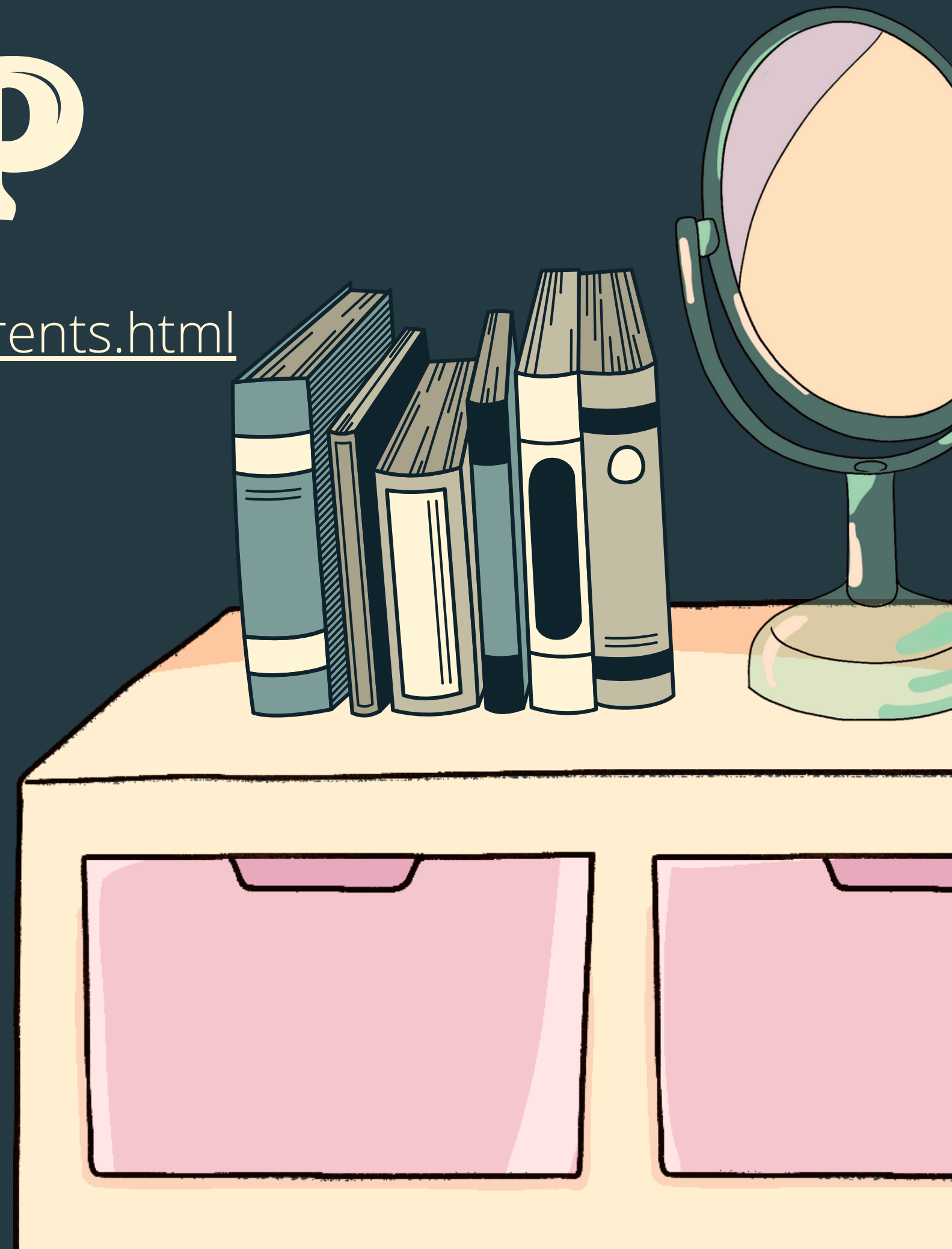
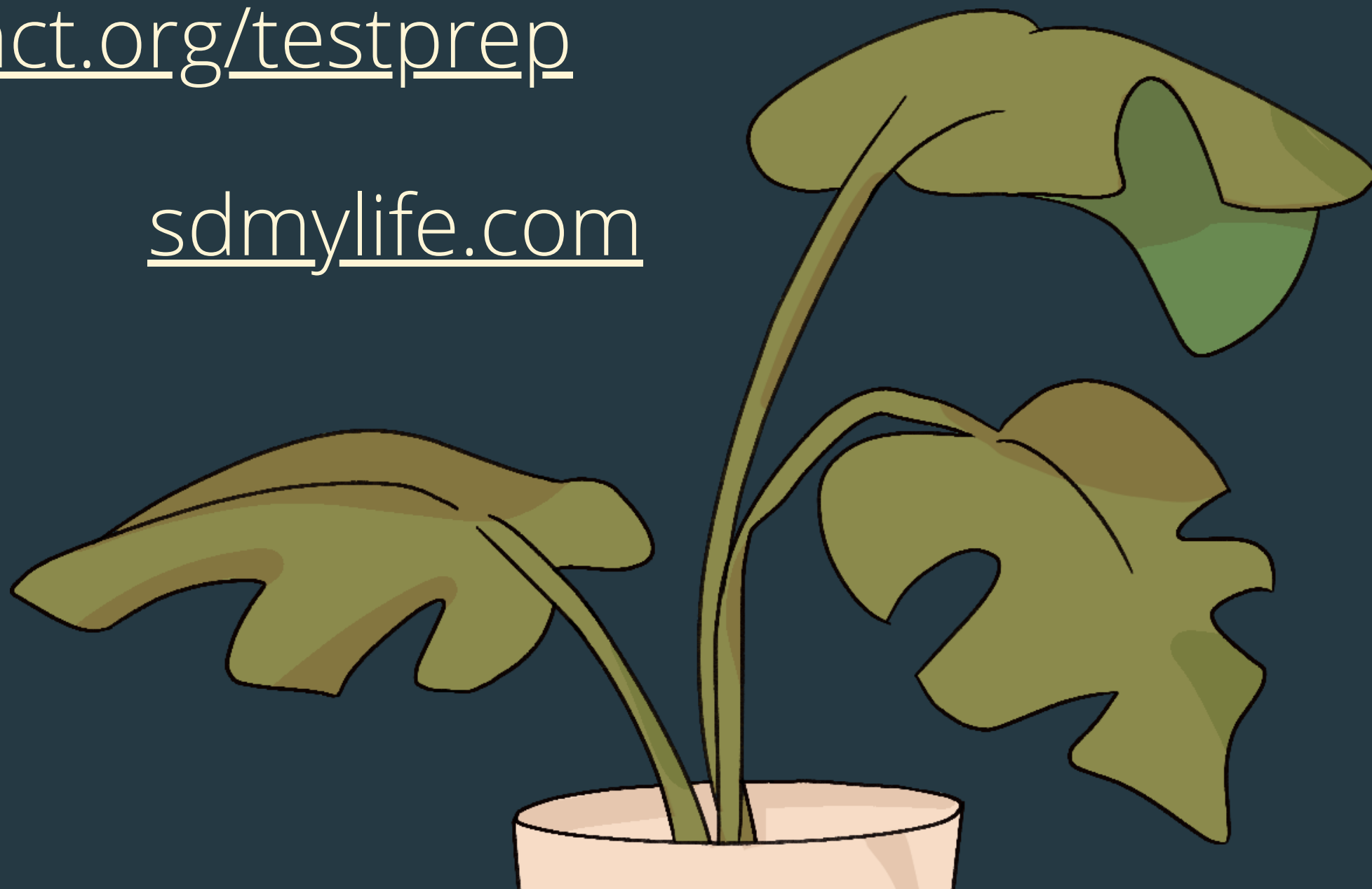

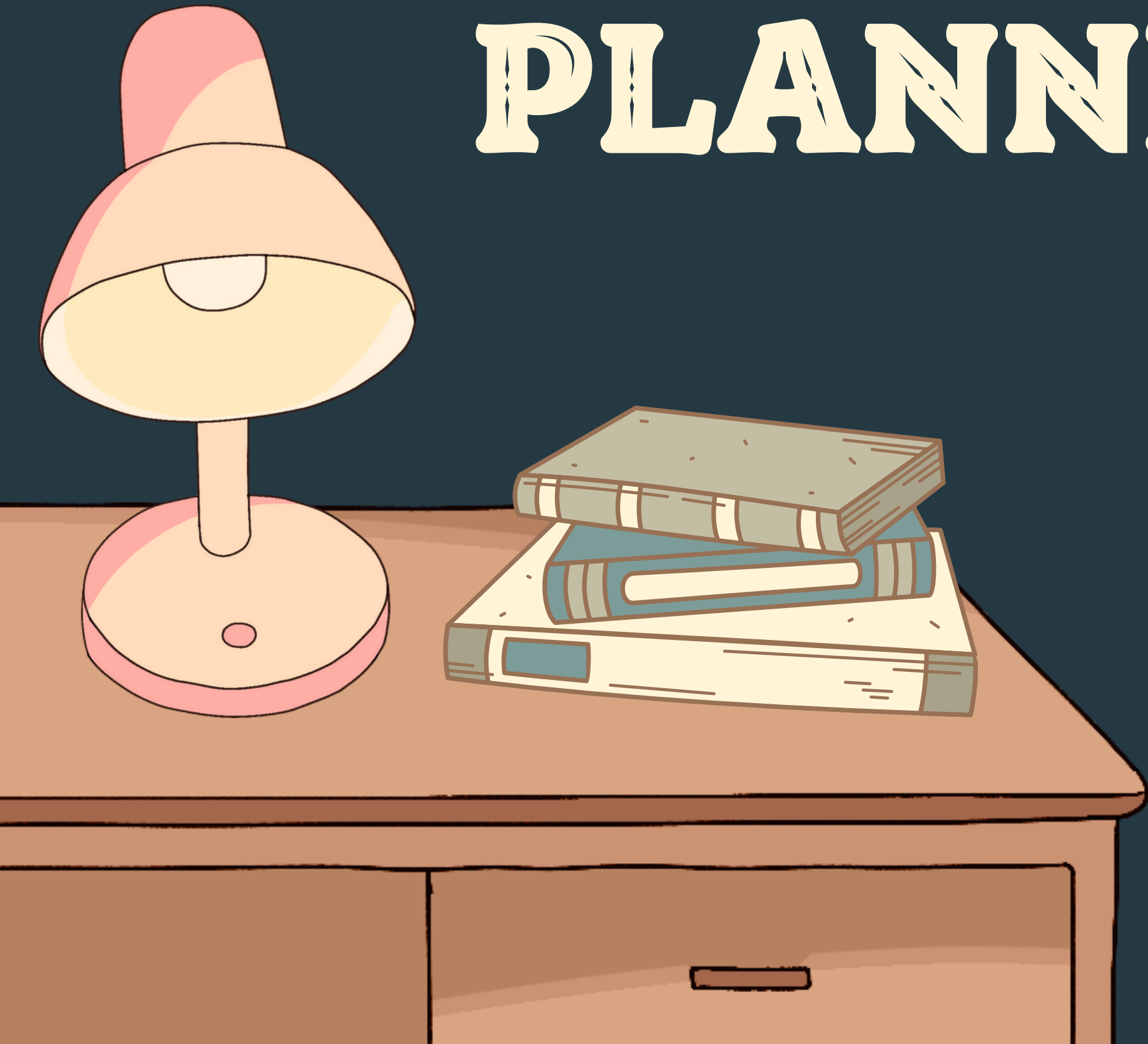
